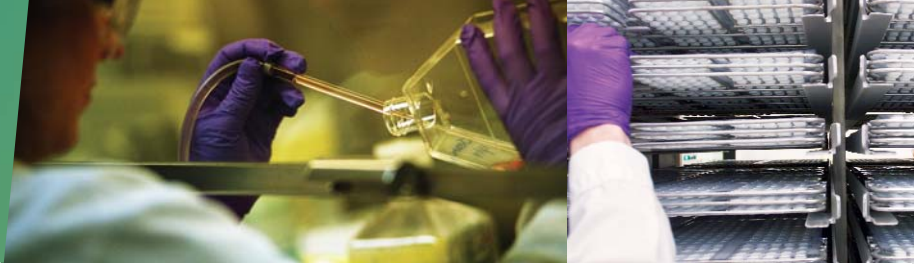


## You're invited to an online educational event
